LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. WITTY, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Revaluation of
settlement land.

10A. On a like application and payment by a lessee of settlement land the Minister shall request the Valuer-General to cause a new valuation of the land to be made, and the provisions of the *last preceding* section shall extend and apply to that land:

Provided that at the expiration of ten years from the date of such new valuation a further valuation of the land shall be made by the Valuer-General, and if the value then determined is increased the rent shall as from the date of such further valuation be proportionately increased during the remainder of the term of the lease, but in no case shall the increased rent exceed the original rent.
