LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Escott, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 41: To omit from the proviso the word "two" and substitute the word "five."

To add the following proviso:—

Provided further that the Minister may at any time after the acquisition by the said land of the mortgagee on giving to the mortgagee not less than three months' notice in writing of his intention so to do, purchase the said land on behalf of the Crown by payment to the mortgagee of—

(a.) The principal moneys owing under the mortgage;

(b.) Interest on those moneys at the rate provided for in the mortgage, computed as from the date of the acquisition by the mortgagee to the date of the purchase; and

(c.) The costs incurred of the mortgagee in connection with the

acquisition of the said land.
