LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. McLEOD, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 6, subclause (1): To omit the new subsection (2A) proposed to be added to section 86 of the principal Act, and substitute the following:—

“(2A) Where in the course of any arbitration proceedings under this section the arbitrators desire to appoint an umpire, they may, with the concurrence of the Minister of Justice, appoint a Stipendiary Magistrate; and if the arbitrators in any case fail to agree as to the appointment of an umpire the Commissioner with the like concurrence shall appoint a Stipendiary Magistrate as umpire.”

Clause 7: To insert, after the words “is hereby amended” in line 42, the following words:—as follows: (a) By inserting, after the words “the interest of a lessee or of a licensee in” in subsection one, the words “any rural”; and (b).
