#### LAW PRACTITIONERS (TRUST ACCOUNTS) BILL (NO. 2)

#### Proposed Amendments

Hon. GEOFFREY PALMER, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

That *clauses 2 and 3* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

#### An Act to amend the Evidence Amendment Act (No. 2) 1980

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Evidence Amendment Act 1985, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Evidence Act 1908.

That *clauses 4 and 5* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 4* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

#### An Act to amend the Summary Proceedings Act 1957

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Summary Proceedings Amendment Act (No. 2) 1985, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Summary Proceedings Act 1957 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That *clauses 6 and 7* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 6* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

#### An Act to amend the Law Practitioners Act 1982

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows: 1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Law Practitioners Amendment Act 1985, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Law Practitioners Act 1982 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper replaces Supplementary Order Paper No. 6 of Wednesday, 7 November 1984. The amendments break the Bill into its 3 component parts, for final enactment

as separate Bills.
