Proposed Amendments

Hon. DOUGLAS GRAHAM, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

New Part 49: To add the following new Part:

PART 49

ELECTORAL ACT 1993

206. Part to be read with Electoral Act 1993—This Part of this Act shall be read together with and deemed part of the Electoral Act 1993* (in this Part referred to as the principal Act).

207. Periodic exercise of Maori option and determination of Maori population—Section 77 (2) of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the expression "2", and substituting the expression "4".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper extends, from 2 months to 4 months, the period that the Minister of Justice may specify as the Maori option period. The Maori option period is a period during which any Maori may exercise the option of being registered either as an elector of a Maori electoral district or as an elector of a General electoral district.
