LEGAL SERVICES BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 2 Separate Bills

Hon. D. A. M. GRAHAM, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *clauses 2 and 3, Parts I to VI, and the First, Second, and Third Schedules* be a separate Bill, with the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to make legal assistance and legal services more readily available to persons of insufficient means, and to repeal the Offenders Legal Aid Act 1954 and the Legal Aid Act 1969

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Legal Services Act 1991.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1992.

That *Part VII* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 140* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Law Practitioners Act 1982

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Law Practitioners Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Law Practitioners Act 1982 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as provided by subsection (3) of this section, this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1991.

(3) **Sections 144 to 146** of this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1992.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper contains the appropriate motion to divide the Legal Services Bill into 2 separate Bills—the Legal Services Bill and the Law Practitioners Amendment Bill.
