LICENSING TRUSTS AMENDMENT BILL

## Proposed Amendment

Hon. Mr McLay, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

Proposed clause 10C: To insert on page 11, after clause 10B, the following clause:

- 10C. Empowering Wiri Trust to lease certain premises (1) Notiwthstanding anything in the principal Act or the Sale of Liquor Act 1962, the Wiri Licensing Trust may grant a lease of its premises known as the Wiri Trust Hotel and situated on the Great South Road, Manukau, to Lion Breweries Limited on such terms and conditions as the Trust thinks fit.
- (2) During the currency of any such lease, the lessee shall be deemed for all the purposes of the principal Act and the Sale of Liquor Act 1962 to be the holder of the hotel premises licence issued in respect of the premises and held at the date of the passing of this Act by the Trust.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This clause empowers the Wiri Licensing Trust to lease its hotel to Lion Breweries Limited, with the intention that that company will conduct the premises for the term of the lease.
