Proposed amendments

Hon Harry Duynhoven, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

*Clause 4: new section 29B(1)(b)(ii)* To add the words "for a term exceeding 12 months" (line 9 on page 5).

## **Explanatory note**

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Land Transport Amendment Bill. The amendment to *clause 4: new section 29B(1)(b)(ii)* would allow individuals sentenced to a term of imprisonment not exceeding 12 months for a conviction for an offence under section 134 or section 135 of the Crimes Act 1961 to apply for reinstatement of their passenger endorsements if their passenger endorsements are deemed to be expired under section 29A(2) of the Land Transport Act 1998 or their passenger endorsements expired during the period beginning on 22 June 2005 and ending with the close of 15 January 2006.
