Land Transfer and Cadastral Survey Legislation Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills

Hon Matt Robson, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *clauses 1 and 2*, *Part 1*, *and Schedules 1 to 4* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words and *clauses 1 to 4* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the Land Transfer (Computer Registers and Electronic Lodgement) Amendment Act 2002.
- In this Act, the Land Transfer Act 1952¹ is called "the principal Act".

Part 1 Preliminary provisions

2 Commencement

- (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3), this Act and Schedules 1, 3, and 4 come into force on 1 June 2002.
- (2) Sections 47, 63, and 64 come into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (3) Sections 45, 46, 48 to 55, 57, 59, 61, 62, 65, 67(1), 68(2), 69, and 69A, and Schedule 2 come into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council; and 1 or more Orders in Council may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part 2 and Schedules 5 to 8* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading to *Part 2* and *clause 70* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Cadastral Survey Act 2002.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 June 2002.
