LAND TENURE AND SETTLEMENT.

Mr. TAYLOR—upon the motion of the Rt. Hon. R. J. Seddon that the House go into Committee of the Whole to consider the report of the Land Commission—to move, by way of amendment, That this House is of the opinion that no legislation affecting the lands of the colony will be satisfactory that does not provide for the cessation of the sale of Crown lands, and is also of the opinion that the remnant of the public estate should be created into a national educational endowment.
