LAND TENURE AND SETTLEMENT.

Mr. Jennings, in Committee on the Rt. Hon. R. J. Seddon's resolutions, to move the addition of the following paragraph:—

That this House is of opinion that all lands in the Auckland and Taranaki Land Districts, but excluding those open under the lands-for-settlement tenure, which were thrown open for selection under the lease-in-perpetuity tenure only be again submitted to those selectors now occupying such sections so that they may reconvert holdings under occupation-with-right of-purchase tenure. [Note.—Selectors were debarred from availing themselves of the provisions of the Land Act, which provides for taking up lands under three options—viz., cash, occupation with right of purchase, and lease in perpetuity.]
