

## SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

### HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Friday, the 1st Day of September, 1905.

#### LAND TENURE AND SETTLEMENT.

Mr. MASSEY, when in Committee of the Whole on the Rt. Hon. R. J. Seddon's resolutions, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 1: After the word "years," in line 3, to insert the words "with the right to purchase and"; in line 5 to strike out the words "or failing which"; to add after the word "improvements," in line 6, the words "should they elect not to renew."

Clause 2: In line 1, to strike out the words "in respect to," and in line 2 the words "whether they are to," and insert in lieu thereof the word "shall"; in line 3, to strike out the words "present market," and insert the word "original."

Clause 3: To strike out " . That, in respect to lessees who now occupy under lease in perpetuity and who have acquired lands under 'The Land Act, 1892,' whether they are to have the right to acquire the freehold of their sections at the capital value upon which they originally selected and"; in line 6 to strike out the word "may," and to insert the letter "s" and the word "may" after the word "lessee"; at the end of the clause to add the words "upon similar terms."

Clause 4 to be clause 3, and in line 1 to strike out the word "shall," and insert the word "that" in lieu thereof; in line 2, after the word "Act," to insert the word "shall," and after the word "sections" to insert the words "at the original value"; to strike out lines 3 and 4, and of line 5 the words "2 and 3 hereof. If lessees allowed to," and insert in lieu thereof the word "the"; in line 5, strike out the word "the" after the word "purchase."

Clause 11: To strike out line 1; in line 3 to strike out the word "there," and insert the word "the"; in line 4, to strike out the words "should be at least one," to insert the letter "s" after the word "tenant," to strike out the words "on each Land Board," and insert the words "in each land district should have the right to elect at least one representative to each Board."
