LAND TENURE AND SETTLEMENT.

Mr. Hogg, in Committee on the Rt. Hon. R. J. Seddon's resolutions, to move the following amendment:—

That it shall be unlawful for any person, or corporation, or company holding an estate of 5,000 acres of land or upwards, valued at over £20,000, to subdivide and execute deeds of conveyance to relatives for such subdivisions if it appears that the object of such subdivision is to prevent closer settlement and reduce taxation.
