LAND TRANSPORT BILL

*Proposed Amendment*

OWEN JENNINGS, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

*Clause 161A:* To omit this clause (lines 18 to 25 on page 196).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper makes a further amendment to the bill to introduce better balance and reasonableness into the bill so far as the rights of individuals are concerned.

*Clause 161A*, which made provision for persons to purchase a proof of identity card separate from a driver licence, is deleted. This provision is not a road safety, or even a transport, measure. "Identity cards" are not required in New Zealand, and have no place in legislation on road safety, and on land transport generally.
