Proposed Amendment

OWEN JENNINGS, in Committee, to move the following amendment: *Clause 161A*: To omit this clause (lines 18 to 25 on page 196).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Supplementary Order Paper makes a further amendment to the bill to introduce better balance and reasonableness into the bill so far as the rights of individuals are concerned.

Clause 161A, which made provision for persons to purchase a proof of identity card separate from a driver licence, is deleted. This provision is not a road safety, or even a transport, measure. "Identity cards" are not required in New Zealand, and have no place in legislation on road safety, and on land transport generally.
