LAND TITLES PROTECTION BILL.

Mr. Heke, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

This Act shall not come into operation until His Majesty's pleasure shall have been taken thereon, and the same shall have been confirmed by His Majesty, with the advice of His Privy Council, and a Proclamation of such confirmation having been given shall have been issued by the Governor and published in the New Zealand Gazette.

After the passing of this Act it shall not be lawful for any person to issue any writ or take any proceedings in the Supreme Court for the purpose of attacking or questioning the title to any land acquired from Natives in New Zealand until His Majesty shall have assented or refused to assent to this Act.
