LAND BILL.

Mr. Mackintosh, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—
230c. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Act, any selector under this Act or any former Land Act may at all times while in the bonâ fide occupation of land, and without license from any Board or Commissioner of Crown Lands, enter upon any State forest and cut or remove therefrom any timber he may require exclusively for his own domestic use, or for fencing the land in his own occupation.

MINING ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Seddon, in Committee, to move a further proviso to section 3, as follows: "Provided also that the Minister may, on the recommendation of any Warden, by Proclamation, withdraw any river, creek, lake, pool, or watercourse from the operation of this Act."
