MINING ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. Cadman, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—
To follow clause 34a:—

34B. Subsection three of section eighty-seven of the principal Act, and also subparagraph three of paragraph (f) of subsection three of section three of "The Mining Act Amendment Act, 1892" (relating to royalty on minerals), are hereby respectively amended by substituting the word "one-hundredth" in lieu of the word "one-fiftieth."

To follow clause 37:—

37a. The powers by subsection twelve of section three hundred and eight of the principal Act conferred upon the Inspector of Mines (save the power to inspect the therein-mentioned machine) may be exercised by any member of the police whom the Inspector of Mines authorises in that behalf, and the provisions of that subsection shall be construed accordingly.
