MASTER AND APPRENTICE BILL.

Mr. SMITH, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 2: Definition of "master," to insert the words "shall mean any officer of the Government to whom any person shall be bound as apprentice under the provisions of this Act, and shall include the successor and successors of each officer in such office; and also":

Clause 21: To strike out the words "section eleven of" and all the words after the word "hereby" in the second line of the clause, and insert the words "repealed, and the provisions of this Act shall apply to apprentices to all skilled handicrafts carried on by the Government or any department thereof."
