MINING ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Moss, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

On death of

At any time after the decease of the holder of a business-site On death of owner Warden may declare or residence-site it shall be lawful for the Warden, on application business-site or residence-site abandoned.

At any time after the decease of the Holder of a publication or residence-site it shall be lawful for the Warden, on application being made by the devisee or next-of-kin, to certify that the said business-site or residence-site to the law, and to grant the said business-site or residence-site to the devisee or next-of-kin, or trustee for the next-of-kin, on such terms and conditions as he may think just.
