MOUNT ALBERT LICENSING TRUST DISSOLUTION BILL

Proposed Amendment

Hon. J. K. McLay, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

<u>Clause 4:</u> To omit the clause on page 3, and substitute the following clause:

- 4. New polls to be held on dissolution of Trust (1) As soon as practicable after the dissolution of the Trust, a poll of the electors residing in the Mount Albert Licensing Trust area shall be held, on a day to be fixed by the Licensing Control Commission on the question whether the area should be incorporated into the Portage Licensing Trust area (hereinafter referred to as the Trust proposal).
- (2) The provisions of subsections (2) to (5) of section 9A of the Licensing Amendment Act 1910, with any necessary amendments, shall

apply as if the Trust proposal were one to which subsection (1) $_{
m Of}$ that section applies.

- (3) If the Trust proposal is carried, the Minister shall, by notice in the <u>Gazette</u>, amend the trust area of the Portage Licensing Trust by including in it the Mount Albert Licensing Trust area, and make such provision for the election of members of the Portage Licensing Trust by persons resident in the Mount Albert Licensing Trust area as the Minister thinks fit.
- (4) If the Trust proposal is not carried, section 9C of the Licensing Amendment Act 1910 shall apply with any necessary amendments.

Explanatory Note

This Bill proposes the automatic incorporation of the Mount Albert Licensing Trust area in the area of the Portage Licensing Trust. Under this clause, that proposal would be subject to a vote of the electors. If the proposal was defeated, the Commission would review the area to determine what licenses should be authorised, and these would be available to private applicants.
