MEAT BILL.

AMENDMENTS proposed by His Excellency the Governor-General:—

Clause 21, subclause (1): To insert at the beginning of this subclause the words: “ Subject to the provisions of section forty-six hereof ”.

Clause 46: To insert, after subclause (1), the following new subclause:—

(1A) Notwithstanding anything in subparagraph (ii) or in subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (b) of the *last preceding* subsection, any meat derived from stock slaughtered on a farm by a *bona fide* farmer in an abattoir district or elsewhere, but otherwise in accordance with the conditions prescribed by the said paragraph, may be sold by him to any person who is regularly employed by him exclusively in connection with farming operations on the same or any other farm.

Part II of First Schedule: To insert the word “ arthritis ” after the word “ anthrax ”; to insert the words “ caseous lymphadenitis ” after the word “ blackleg ”; to insert the words “ peritonitis (septic), pleurisy (septic) ” after the word “ mange ”.
