NOTICES RELATING TO ORDERS OF THE DAY.

MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. BAIN, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Section 10. To omit the following words: “and moneys belonging to the borough which are appropriated for special purposes,” and insert in lieu thereof the following words: “for waterworks or gasworks.”

Section 21. To add the following subsection:—

(e.) For regulating and making provision for the construction of chimneys to carry away the smoke from steam-engines, and for insuring protection from sparks therefrom, and for the prevention of nuisances from smoke.

Strike out sections 25 and 29.

To add the following new clauses:—

Where a recreation reserve adjoins a borough, and where it is already vested in the Mayor and Burgesses of the Borough, but is not within the boundaries, the Governor may, upon resolution of the Mayor and Council, declare that it shall form part of the borough.

That the Borough of Invercargill, proclaimed under “The Municipal Corporations Act, 1876,” shall, from the passing of this Act, be designated the “City of Invercargill.”
