MENTAL DEFECTIVES AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed Amendments

Hon. Mr Marshall, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 1: To omit the words "the Mental Defectives Amendment Act 1954", and substitute the words "the Mental Health Amendment Act 1954"; and to insert, after the words "deemed part of", the words "the Act heretofore cited as ".

New Clause

To insert, after clause 1, the following new clause:

1A. (1.) The principal Act may hereafter be cited as Altering Short Titles the Mental Health Act 1911. (2) The Short Title of the principal Act, and the Act and Short Titles of-(a) The Mental Defectives Amendment Act 1914; See Reprint

(f) The Mental Defectives Amendment Act 1951—1951, No. 47 are hereby consequentially amended, in each case, by omitting the word "Defectives" and substituting the word "Health".

(3) Every reference in any enactment to the Short Title of any of the said Acts is hereby consequentially amended by omitting the word "Defectives", and substituting the word "Health".
