MAORI LAND CLAIMS ADJUSTMENT AND LAWS AMENDMENT.

Mr. Kaihau, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

A. The Appellate Court is hereby authorised and directed to review the report of the Royal Commission in connection with disputes affecting the title to the Te Akau Block (Parliamentary Paper G.-1, 1904), and the subsequent decisions of the Chief Judge, under the provisions of section fourteen of "The Maori Land Claims Adjustment and Laws Amendment Act, 1904," thereon, and also to investigate and determine the claims according to Maori custom of the Maoris to the said land, and the interests of the hapus, and each individual to the said land, and also to vary and amend the boundary-line between Te Akau No. 2 and Te Akau No. 2B, also the boundary between Te Akau No. 3B and Te Akau No. 3A, and to make such orders as it considers necessary to effect a final and equitable settlement of the matters in dispute.
