MAORI LAND LAWS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Moss, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

35. If any Judge knowingly adjudicates on any matter wherein he has directly or indirectly any pecuniary interest, or if he shall purchase from the Natives to whom he has awarded it any land within one year from the date of the judgment awarding the same, then he shall be liable on conviction upon indictment in any competent Court to imprisonment with or without hard labour for any term not exceeding two years, or to a penalty not exceeding two hundred pounds.
