SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Wednesday, the 16th Day of October, 1905.

MAORI LAND SETTLEMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. CARROLL, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

After the words "principal Act," on page 1, line 23, to insert the words "and on the appointment of any such Board such Council shall cease to exist."

On page 2, to strike out the word "surplus," in line 9. And on the same page, after the words "provisions of this Act," in line 21, to add the words "and the said land shall vest in the Board accordingly."

On page 3, in line 7, to strike out the words "Provided that a definite," and insert in lieu thereof the words "(g.) The Board may set aside any"; and in line 8, to strike out the words "may set aside."

On the same page, in line 10, to strike out the words "new proviso"; and in line 11, to strike out the words "Provided further that," and make the remaining words subsection (h.)

On page 4, after the words "Settlers Act, 1894," in line 29, to insert the following words:—

"(c.) Notwithstanding anything in the *last preceding* subsection the whole or any part of any such advance may be repaid at any time before the same becomes payable under that subsection, and in every such case a proper adjustment of the interest payable shall be made."

On page 6, in lines 2 and 3, to strike out all the words "the Native Minister shall cause to be removed from the title to all Maori lands"; in line 5, to strike out the words "such lands," and insert in lieu thereof the words "any lands owned by Maoris"; in line 7, after the words "instrument of title," to insert the words "shall be deemed to be removed"; in line 8 to strike out the words "alienation by"; in line 11 to strike out the words "Provided further that no"; in the same line, after the word "shall," to insert the word "not": in line 17 to strike out the words "affected by such proposed alienation," and insert in lieu thereof the words "proposed to be leased"; in line 18 to strike out the words "Maori alienation," and insert in lieu thereof the word "lessor"; in line 20 to strike out the word "alienation," and insert in lieu thereof the word "lease"; in line 35 to strike out the words "hereinbefore" and "hereinafter," and insert in lieu thereof the words, "heretofore" and "hereafter" respectively.

To transpose clauses 16A and 16B.

To insert the following new clause:—

16c.—Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the principal Act, elected members of any Council who held office immediately prior to the thirteenth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and five, shall be deemed to have continued to hold office, and shall, unless removed in accordance with law, continue to hold office until the appointment of a Board under this Act. No act of any Council shall be called in question merely on the ground that the statutory term of office of the Council or of any member thereof expired on the said thirteenth day of August.

PIRE WHAKANOHONOHO WHENUA MAORI.

Honore TIMI KARA, i roto i te Komiti ka motini i nga whakatikatika e whai ake nei:—

I muri i nga kupu "tino Ture," i wharangi 1, raina 23, me whakauru nga kupu nei "a ina whakaturia taua Paori ka mutu i reira te tu o taua Kaunihera."

I wharangi 2, me patu te kupu "toenga," i raina 2. A i taua wharangi ano i muri i nga kupu "tikanga o tenei Ture," i raina 14, me apiti atu nga kupu nei "a hei reira ka tau pera aua whenua ki te Poari."

I wharangi 3, i raina 10, me patu nga kupu "Engari me whakatuturu te maha," a me whakauru hei riiwhi mo aua kupu "(g.) Me ahei te Poari ki te wehe i etahi"; a i raina 11, me patu nga kupu "e ahei ana kia wehea."

I taua wharangi ano i raina 13 me patu nga kupu "kupu hou"; a i raina 14, me patu te kupu "Engari," a ko te roanga atu me karanga ko wahanga tekiona (h.).

I wharangi 4, i muri i nga kupu "Noho Whenua, 1894," i raina 46, me whakauru enei kupu e whai ake nei:—

"(c.) Ahakoa nga kupu o te wahanga tekiona i runga tonu ake nei ko te katoa ko tetahi wahi ranei o taua moni nama me whakaea a ona wa e pai ai i mua atu i te ra kua whakaritea hei utunga i raro i taua tekiona, a i ia keehi pera me whakatikatika nga initaretu e utua ana."

I wharangi 6, raina 39 me 40, me patu katoa nga kupu "me whakahau e te Minita mo nga Mea Maori kia whakakorea atu i roto i nga taitara ki nga whenua Maori"; i raina 42, me patu nga kupu "aua whenua," a me whakauru hei riiwhi ko enei kupu "nga whenua Maori"; i raina 43, i muri i nga kupu "taitara ranei," me whakauru nga kupu "ka kiiia kua whakakorea"; i raina 47, me patu nga kupu "Engari." I wharangi 7, raina 3, me patu nga kupu "e pangia ana e taua tuku," a me whakauru hei whakahapi i era ko enei kupu "e meatia ana kia riihitia"; i raina 4, me patu nga kupu "Maori e tuku ana," a me riiwhi atu ki enei kupu "kai-tuku riihi"; i raina 6 me patu te kupu "tuku," a me whakauru hei riiwhi "riihi"; i raina 23 me patu nga kupu "runga" me "raro," a me riiwhi atu ki enei kupu "mua" me "muri."

ME whakawhitiwhiti a tekiona 16A me 16B.

ME whakauru te tekiona hou e whai ake nei:—

16B. Ahakoa nga kupu e takoto ke ana te tikanga i roto i te tino Ture, ko nga mema i pootitia hei mema mo te Kaunihera i mua tonu atu o te tekau ma toru o nga ra o Akuhata, kotahi mano e iwa rau ma rima, ka kiiia kei te tu tonu ratou hei mema, a ki te kore e whakamutua i runga i te Ture, me tu tonu a taea noatia te ra e whakaturia ai te Poari i raro i tenei Ture. Kaore tetahi mahi a te Kaunihera i mahi ai e taea te whakahe i runga i te take kua pau nga tau i whakaturia ai te Kaunihera, tetahi mema ranei, i te tekau ma toru o nga ra o Akuhata kua kiiia ane nei.
