MISUSE OF DRUGS AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed Amendments

HON. T.F. GILL, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

That clauses 47 and 48 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 47 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Criminal Justice Act 1954
BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title - This Act may be cited as the Criminal Justice Amendment Act 1978, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Criminal Justice Act 1954 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That clauses 49 and 50 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 49 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Penal Institutions Act 1954
BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title - This Act may be cited as the Penal Institutions Amendment Act 1978, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Penal Institutions Act 1954 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

That clauses 51 and 52 be a separate Bill, and that for clause 51 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Summary Proceedings Act 1957
BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title - This Act may be cited as the Summary Proceedings Amendment Act 1978, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Summary Proceedings Act 1957 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

To omit clause 53.
