Proposed Amendments

Hon. Mr Corbett, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 6, subclause (1): To omit the word "him" in line 25, and substitute the words "the lessee".

Clause 8: To insert, after subclause (1), the following subclause:

(1A) Where any subsisting lease is subject to a mortgage, no arrangement or agreement for the settlement or discharge of the lessee's rights shall be made under this section without the consent of the mortgagee.

Clause 9, subclause (5): To omit from line 39 the word "determined", and substitute the word "extinguished".

Clause 9: To add the following subclause:

(9) Where any subsisting lease is subject to a mortgage, no agreement for the determination of the lessee's rights in accordance with the terms of his lease shall be made under this section without the consent of the mortgagee.

Clause 61: To insert, after subclause (2), the following subclause:

(2A) The provisions of subsection *two* of this section shall extend and apply to the sale of any vested land which is subject to a lease and which is, pursuant to the provisions of section *seventy* of this Act, revested in the person or persons for the time being beneficially entitled thereto.

Clause 61, subclause (3): To omit the words "Any such sale" in line 1, and substitute the words "Subject to the provisions of subsection two of this section, any sale by the Maori Trustee under this section".
