NAPIER HARBOUR BOARD EMPOWERING AND LOAN BILL.

Mr. BROWN, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Poll of ratepayers to be taken to determine amount of loan and work to be carried out.

7A. Before any amount is raised for the purpose of carrying out any work that may be undertaken by virtue of this Act the ratepayers of the Harbour District shall at a poll to be taken for the purpose have the following questions submitted to them and determined in the manner indicated in the original Act:—

- (a.) I am in favour of raising a loan of three hundred thousand pounds for the purpose of carrying out the scheme submitted to the Board by Messrs. Cullen and Kiele for an inner harbour.
- (b.) I am opposed to raising the sum of three hundred thousand pounds as aforesaid.
- (c.) I am in favour of raising a loan of one hundred thousand pounds for the purpose of improving the present break-water harbour on the plans of Messrs. Maxwell, Williams, and Mason.
- (d.) I am opposed to raising the sum of one hundred thousand pounds as aforesaid.
