NATIVE LAND AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. Herries, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 8 (2): Omit the word "passing" in line 46, and substitute the word "commencement."

Clause 8: Add the following subclause:-

(3.) The provisions of section two hundred and nine of the principal Act with respect to the precedent consent of a Maori Land Board to alienations of Native land and with respect to alienations made in pursuance of such consent shall be deemed to extend and apply, and at all times to have extended and applied, to alienations of undivided interests in Native land and to alienations of part only of any area of Native land owned by the same owners; and the validity and operation of every such precedent consent granted by a Maori Land Board before the commencement of this Act, and of every alienation or confirmation made or granted, whether before or after the commencement of this Act, in pursuance of any such consent shall be determined accordingly.
