NATIVE LAND COURT ACTS AMENDMENT.

Hon. Mr. MITCHELSON to move,—

Section 31. Add “until the expiration of the period of *six* months within which application for inquiry may be made to the Commissioners, and for the purpose of questioning the validity of any alienation in respect of which such application is made, until the end of the next session of Parliament.”

Where an application is made to the Commissioners to inquire into any alienation or acquisition of land already registered under “The Land Transfer Act, 1885,” the applicant shall at the same time lodge with the District Land Registrar of the district in which the land is situate a copy of such application. The said Registrar shall thereupon enter a caveat against the land mentioned in such application. A caveat so entered shall not be removed unless and until the Commissioners have given to the applicant a certificate under the thirtieth section, or until the end of the next session of Parliament if such certificate be refused.
