## NATIONAL PARKS BILL

*Proposed Amendments*

Hon. V. S. YOUNG, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

*Clause 39 (2) (a)*: To omit from line 11 on page 23 the number "8".

*Clause 54 (1)*: To omit from lines 24 and 25 on page 34 the proposed *paragraph (g)* as reported from the Lands and Agriculture Committee, and substitute the following paragraph:

(g) Prohibiting or regulating the use or parking of vehicles or the use of mooring of boats in any park:

To insert at line 31 on that page, after *paragraph (h)*, the following paragraph:

(ha) Prohibiting or regulating the use of any internal combustion engine in any park, whether or not that engine is the means of propulsion of any vehicle, boat, machinery, or appliance:

*Clause 67 (1)*: To omit from lines 25 and 26 on page 44 the words "or by any ranger appointed under the Wildlife Act 1953".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*Clause 39 (2)* prohibits the delegation of certain powers of the Minister. The amendment is consequential upon the amendment to *clause 8* which, as amended, does not confer any powers on the Minister.

*Clause 54*: The proposed *clause 54 (1) (g)* makes it clear that bylaws may be made prohibiting or regulating the parking of vehicles and the mooring of boats in a national park. At present, there is some doubt as to whether or not the parking of vehicles and the mooring of boats is included in the term "use of vehicles or boats".

The proposed *clause 54 (1) (ha)* makes it clear that bylaws may be made prohibiting or regulating the use of internal combustion engines such as those used to power portable generators. At present, there is doubt as to the power to make such bylaws.

*Clause 67 (1)*: The words removed from *clause 67 (1)* are redundant following the change to *clause 38 (8)* which confers upon rangers appointed under the Wildlife Act 1953 all the powers of a ranger appointed under the Bill.
