POISONS IMPORTATION AND CARRIAGE BILL.

Hon. Mr. SEDDON, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 2. Line 13, after the words “watertight drum,” insert “or strong and hermetically-sealed zinc case protected by wood.”

Clause 4. Line 22, after the words “red-lead paint,” insert “or in strong and hermetically-sealed zinc cases protected by wood.”

NATIVE TOWNSHIPS BILL.

Hon. Mr. J. MCKENZIE, in Committee, to move to amend clause 18:—

(1.) By inserting at the beginning of the clause the words “With respect to the land comprised in any Native township under this Act which at the time of the passing of this Act is subject to any notification under section sixteen of “The Native Land Purchases Act, 1892,” but not further or otherwise.”

(2.) By striking out the words “Native township,” and inserting in lieu thereof “such land.”

(3.) By striking out the last sentence of the clause, as amended by the Native Affairs Committee.
