NOXIOUS WEEDS BILL.

Mr. BUDDO, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clauses :—

12. In any case where the tenant-occupier and owner are jointly liable under the terms of this Act to clear infected land, the owner may claim the right to jointly carry out any order of the local authority.

13. Any tenant-occupier whose lease dates prior to the coming into force of this Act shall have the right to apply to the Stipendiary Magistrate's Court of the district for an order to cancel and determine his lease, and the Magistrate shall grant such order if he is satisfied that the tenant is damaged pecuniarily by the operation of this Act.
