NEW ZEALAND UNIVERSITY AMENDMENT BILL

Hon. Mr MASON, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

To add the following new clause:

9. **Honorary degrees**—Section twelve of the New Zealand University Amendment Act 1928 is hereby amended as from the sixth day of August, nineteen hundred and fifty-eight, by omitting from subsection two the words “the Academic Board”, and substituting the words “a joint committee consisting of the Chancellor (or, in his absence, the Pro-Chancellor), the Vice-Chancellor, the Chairman of the Academic Board, three members of the Senate nominated by the Senate (being members who are not qualified to be members of the Academic Board), and three members of the Academic Board nominated by the Academic Board”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 9: Under section 12 (2) of the New Zealand University Amendment Act 1928 no honorary degree shall be conferred by the Senate on any person unless the person has been recommended therefor by the Academic Board. The clause provides that, from 6 August 1958, the recommendation must be made by a joint committee representative of the Senate and the Academic Board and constituted as specified above.
