#### OATHS BILL.

Hon. Captain RUSSELL, in Committee, to move the following new clause, after clause 6 :—

Taking of  
affidavits in  
Resident Magis-  
trates' Courts.

6A. All affidavits and declarations to be used in any Resident Magistrate's Court may be sworn or taken before any solicitor of the Supreme Court, or before any Justice of the Peace, or before the Clerk of any Resident Magistrate's Court.

Affidavits by  
company,  
corporation, &c.

Affidavits and declarations required to be used in any Resident Magistrate's Court by any corporation or incorporated company may be made on their behalf by any officer, attorney, or agent of such corporation or incorporated company, and may be made on behalf of any party in an action by his solicitor or duly-appointed agent.
