OLD-AGE PENSIONS BILL.

Mr. G. HUTCHISON, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

The pension hereinbefore provided shall, subject to the total amount which would be payable if no variation were made, be varied as follows:—

- (1.) If the applicant shall have refrained from applying until he is sixty-nine years or upwards, twenty-seven pounds per year:
- (2.) If the applicant shall have refrained from applying until he is seventy-five, thirty-six pounds or upwards.
