AUCTIONEERS BILL.

1. Mr. Fish, in Committee, to move the following new clause:

No person being a licensed auctioneer or sharebroker under this Act shall at the same time act as a manager or secretary of any mining or other Company.

Every person offending against this provision shall for every such offence be liable to a penalty not exceeding fifty pounds, to be recovered

by any person who may sue for same.

2. Mr. Stevens, in Committee, to move the insertion of the following new clause:--

> It shall be lawful for any auctioneer to sell by public auction, at any time during the day or night, any produce, trees, flowers, plants, or exhibits of whatsoever kind which may be exhibited at any agricultural or horticultural show, or at any show held under the auspices of any farmers' club or association.

3. Major Harris, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—
In line 20, clause 2, after the word "thereof," insert, "(provided always that, in estimating the value of real property, the unimproved value only of such property shall be taken)," so that the clause shall read as follows:-

"For and in respect of all property: for every twenty shillings of the value thereof (provided always that, in estimating the value of real property, the unimproved value only of such property shall be taken) the duty of. "
