Property (Relationships) Amendment Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 4 Bills

Hon Margaret Wilson, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 1A, Part 1, and the Schedules* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 1A*, and the Part heading before *clause 2* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Property (Relationships) Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Act that was previously called the Matrimonial Property Act 1976¹ is called "the principal Act".

1A Commencement

Except as provided in sections 22(2), 56(4), and 56(6), this Act comes into force on 1 February 2002.

That *clauses 58 to 68* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 58* and the Part heading and heading before that clause there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Administration Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Administration Act 1969² is called "the principal Act".

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on **1 February 2002**.

That *clauses 69 to 84* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 69* and the heading before that clause there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Family Proceedings Amendment Act **2001**.
- (2) In this Act, the Family Proceedings Act 1980³ is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on **1 February 2002**.

That *clauses 85 to 91* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 85* and the heading before that clause there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Family Protection Amendment Act **2001**.
- (2) In this Act, the Family Protection Act 1955⁴ is called “the principal Act”.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on **1 February 2002**.
