POST AND TELEGRAPH AMENDMENT BILL.

Amendment proposed by His Excellency the Governor:— To add the following new clause:—

Postmaster-General may issue licenses for wirelesstelegraphy registered in

New Zealand.

3. (1.) The Minister of Telegraphs may, in accordance with regulations to be made in that behalf by the Governor in Council, grant licenses for the installation and working of apparatus for wireless stations on ships telegraphy (within the meaning of Part X of the principal Act) on board any ship registered in New Zealand, and whether on the high seas or in New Zealand waters.

> (2.) Subject to any such regulation, every such license shall be in such form and for such period, and shall contain such terms, conditions, and restrictions as the Postmaster-General thinks fit.

> (3.) The Governor may by Order in Council make such regulation as he thinks proper as to the granting of such licenses, and as to the form, period, terms, conditions, and restrictions thereof, and as to the fees payable in respect thereof.
