PHARMACY BILL (No. 2).

Hon. Mr. Sullivan, in Committee, to move the following amendments:---

Clause 33: To add to this clause the following new paragraph (in lieu of the new paragraph recommended by the Public Health Committee):—

(g) Any person who at the commencement of this Act is a member of the New Zealand Association of Medical Herbalists (Incorporated), and is then engaged in carrying on business as a herbalist, or any person, being a member of the said Association, who, with the consent of the Minister, commences to carry on business as a herbalist after the commencement of this Act, if, in any such case, the following conditions are complied with, namely:—

(i) The business is carried on at one address only of which notice in writing has been given by the proprietor to the Registrar; and

(ii) The business is carried on by the proprietor personally or under his immediate supervision and control.

Clause 33: To add the following subclause:---

(2) Nothing in paragraph (g) of the *last preceding* subsection shall be construed to limit the powers conferred on the Governor-General by paragraph (c) of subsection *four* of the *last preceding* section.
