PRIVACY COMMISSIONER BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 10 Separate Bills

Hon. D. A. M. Graham, in Committee, to move as follows:

That Parts I to IV and the First, Second, and Third Schedules be a separate Bill with the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act-

(a) To provide for the appointment of a Privacy Commissioner, and to define the Commissioner's functions and powers; and (b) To provide for matters incidental thereto

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Privacy Commissioner Act **1991**.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 39 and 40* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 39* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Births and Deaths Registration Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Births and Deaths Registration Act 1951.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 41 and 42* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 41* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Penal Institutions Act 1954

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Penal Institutions Amendment Act **1991**, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Penal Institutions Act 1954.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 43 and 44* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 43* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Marriage Act 1955

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Marriage Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marriage Act 1955.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 45 and 46* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 45* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Customs Act 1966

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Customs Amendment Act (No. 3) 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Customs Act 1966.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 47 to 50* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 47* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Inland Revenue Department Act 1974

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Inland Revenue Department Amendment Act (No. 3) 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Inland Revenue Department Act 1974 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 51 to 54* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 51* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Human Rights Commission Act 1977

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Human Rights Commission Amendment Act 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Human Rights Commission Act 1977 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent. That *clauses 55 and 56* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 55* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Accident Compensation Act 1982 BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Accident Compensation Amendment Act (No. 3) 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Compensation Act 1982.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 57 and 58* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 57* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Immigration Act 1987

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Immigration Amendment Act (No. 2) **1991**, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Immigration Act 1987.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *clauses 59 and 60* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 59* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Education Act 1989

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Education Amendment Act (No. 3) 1991, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Education Act 1989.

(2) This Act shall come into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
