PUBLIC DOMAINS ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. Duncan, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

Domains not to be let for building.

3. No portion of any domain used for public recreation shall be offered for lease in allotments for the purposes of building, and no building or erection shall be placed or erected by any tenant on any part of any public domain, reserve, or recreation-ground.

Bush to be preserved.

4. The natural bush on any domain or reserve set apart for the purposes of public recreation shall not be cut or destroyed without the approval of the Minister of Lands being first obtained.

Annual report.

5. A report of the proceedings of every Domain Board for each year shall, within one month from the date of each annual meeting of the Board, be sent to the Minister of Lands; and such report shall include a statement of the receipts and expenditure for the year ended the thirty-first December prior to the annual meeting.
