PATENTS, DESIGNS, AND TRADE-MARKS BILL.

Hon. Mr. LEE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 135: To insert, after subclause (1), the following subclauses:—

(1A.) Every person not registered as a Patent Agent before the first day of October, nineteen hundred and *twenty-one*, who proves to the satisfaction of the Registrar that he was on that date *bonâ fide* practising as a Patent Agent, whether individually or as a member of a firm or as a manager or director of a company, shall be entitled to be registered as a Patent Agent if he makes application for the purpose within six months from the date of the commencement of this Act unless, after giving an applicant an opportunity of being heard, the Registrar is satisfied that he has, while so practising, been guilty of such misconduct as would have rendered him liable, if his name had been on the Register of Patent Agents, to have his name erased therefrom.

(1B.) Every person enrolled as a solicitor of the Supreme Court of New Zealand shall be entitled to be registered as a Patent Agent.
