PUBLIC HEALTH AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir J. G. WARD, in Committee, to move the following amendments :—

In clause 14 : To omit the words “it shall be lawful for the local authority, in addition to its other rating powers, to raise the amount required by,” and to substitute in lieu thereof the words “the local authority may, in addition to its other rating powers, by special order make and levy.”

To add to clause 14 the following new subclause :—

(2.) Where such expenses are or have been incurred for the benefit of some portion of the district defined by the special order the separate rate may be made and levied on that portion only.
