PUBLIC HEALTH AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Sir J. G. Ward, in Committee, to move the addition of the following subclause to clause 11:—

(5.) Where a building or any part thereof is required under this section to be pulled down, it shall not be removed for the purpose of being re-erected as a dwellinghouse, shop, or factory, or as a dairy or place where any article of food for human consumption may be kept, nor shall any part of the materials of which such building or part thereof was composed be used, without the consent of the District Health Officer, in the construction of any building used for any such purpose.
