

## SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

#### PUBLIC HEALTH BILL.

Hon. Mr. WARD, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

In clause 38 insert the following new subclause:—

(10A.) In respect of every hospital under this section there shall be payable out of moneys to be appropriated by Parliament subsidies at the same rate and in the same manner as provided by “The Hospitals and Charitable Institutions Act, 1885,” in the case of hospitals under that Act.

(10B.) The subsidies shall be payable to the local authority or local authorities by which the hospital is provided and maintained.

In clause 138. Definition of “lymph”: Add, after “heifer,” at end of definition (line 18), “and supplied by the Government.”

Insert the following new clause, to follow 171:—

171A. For the purposes of this Part of this Act, the Colonial Secretary shall at all times cause to be kept at convenient places throughout New Zealand an adequate quantity of pure vaccine lymph, for the purpose of supplying the same in reasonable quantities, and without cost, to Public Vaccinators and medical practitioners on application in that behalf in the prescribed manner.
