RESTRAINT OF INCITEMENTS TO BETTING OR WAGERING BILL.

Mr. W. HUTCHISON, in Committee, to move the following additions to clause 2:—

2A. Every person frequenting, using, or being in or on any street for the purpose of betting or wagering, and every person who, being a bookmaker, shall, either himself or by means of any agent or clerk or servant, bet with any person in or on any street, shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding *one hundred* pounds, or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding *three* months, or to both a fine and imprisonment.

2B. Where any money is stolen or embezzled and paid to any person as, or for, or by way of, or on account of a wager or bet, the person from whom such money was stolen or embezzled may, in any Court of competent jurisdiction, recover such money, or any sum not exceeding the amount thereof, from the person to whom the same was so paid.

2c. In this Act the expression "street" shall include and apply to every street, lane, footway, or thoroughfare on any public or private property, and shall also extend to and include any enclosed or unenclosed land (not including houses) within any city or town: and the expression "bookmaker" shall include any person who carries on the business of, or acts as, a bookmaker or turf commission agent, or any person who gains or endeavours to gain his livelihood wholly or partly by betting or wagering.

PROPERTY LAW AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Major STEWARD, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

New clause.

The term or currency of any mortgage may be renewed or extended by a memorandum, in writing indorsed thereon or attached thereto, signed by both mortgagor and mortgagee, and attested as in section two of this Act provided, and such memorandum of renewal or extension may be registered in the same manner as is prescribed in the case of the registration of mortgages.

MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS ACT 1886 AMENDMENT BILL.

Dr. NEWMAN, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

Section 185 of "The Municipal Corporations Act, 1886," is hereby amended by the omission of the words, "comprising, if the borough is divided into wards only, an entire ward or entire wards thereof," occurring in the second and third lines thereof.
