PROPERTY LAW AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. ROLLESTON, in Committee, to move to add the following new clause:—

Mortgages Final
Extension Act,
1924, repealed.

8. Whereas by the Mortgages Final Extension Act, 1924, provision was made whereby the term of any mortgage to which that Act applied could, by means of an extension order made by the Supreme Court, or, in certain cases, by a Stipendiary Magistrate, be extended to a date not later than the thirty-first day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-seven: And whereas all extension orders made under the authority of the said Act have now expired, and it is desirable that the said Act should be repealed: Be it therefore enacted as follows:—

The Mortgages Final Extension Act, 1924, is hereby repealed.
